Surplus Property Resolution

WHEREAS, the Riverside Fire Authority periodically needs to sell or dispose of real property that is no longer needed because it has been replaced or has become obsolete; and

WHEREAS, a fire authority has the ability to carry out their purposes and to that end may sell or dispose of property according to RCW 52.12.021; and

WHEREAS, a review of RCW 52 indicates that there is no mandatory statutory procedure required for the sale or disposal of property by an authority; and


WHEREAS, staff has developed the enclosed list of surplus property to be traded in or to be disposed of if nonworking; and

WHEREAS, the Governance Board has determined that it is in the best interest of residents, property owners and taxpayers of the Authority that the outdated equipment be traded in for the value of service credits towards future equipment maintenance;


