Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Volunteer with Riverside Fire Authority. Service as a Volunteer is a challenging and rewarding way to perform community service, gain work experience, or start a potential career path. To be considered for a volunteer position, you must meet all minimum requirements and possess the required certifications or licenses listed below:

*Must be 18 years of Age	*Must possess current WA	*High School diploma or	
	drivers license	equivalent	

The Riverside Fire Authority is a combination department consisting of paid staff complemented by an experienced and diverse volunteer group. The RFA is governed by a Board of elected Fire Commissioners responsible for determining service levels, adopting policy, and financial oversight. The Administrative Section is comprised of the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief/Fire Marshal, Secretary to the Board, an Administrative Assistant, and a Volunteer Recruitment and Retention Coordinator.

The service area encompasses approximately 185 square miles of Northwest Lewis County including the City of Centralia. An estimated 25,000 citizens are served by the Fire Authority. Annual call volume is in excess of 4,000 calls.

Six unmanned stations surround the service area and are staffed by come from home volunteers, who are notified of emergencies through paging systems and respond when available. Two of the six stations have Resident quarters affording additional staffing for Seminary Hill and Cooks Hill areas. Pearl Street Station 1 and Harrison Avenue Station 2 are staffed 24/7 with an officer and paramedic.

To apply, please carefully read and complete all attached pages. We accept completed and signed applications during business hours at Station 2 at 1818 Harrison Ave.

Applicants moving forward in the process (for any volunteer position) will be scheduled for orientation/training academy. In between academies, recruit volunteers may be invited to attend weekly drills as an observer to become acquainted with other volunteers, apparatus, and stations. Academy is designed to provide recruits with basic, fundamental skills required to safely function at emergency incidents. The academy is divided into modules and is conducted during a combination of weekday evenings and weekend days. Recruits need to maintain an 80% or greater quiz average and attend all classes unless excused by Recruit Academy Coordinator.

All prospective volunteers will be required to successfully complete a physical agility test and medical evaluation prior to beginning physical activity in recruit academy.

At the conclusion of academy, Recruits will be eligible to respond to emergencies and participate in most training activities. Successfully completing the recruit academy marks the beginning of a probationary period where additional learning will occur through a task book system.

Volunteers will be issued all required protective clothing and equipment. Volunteers receive a modest stipend for answering emergency calls and attending training sessions. Please consider the following time commitments before submitting your application:

If accepted into the Volunteer program, you will be required to:

- Attend monthly required training.
- Complete mandatory academies and complete assigned task books.
- Volunteer for shifts or respond to a percentage of calls in response area.

All applicants for career and volunteer positions with the Riverside Fire Authority will have their driving records evaluated. Riverside Fire Authority uses the violation point system listed below. If your permanent driving record reflects a total of six (6) points or more for a period of 36 months (3 years) preceding the date of your application, you will not be allowed to continue in the process. Therefore, if you know that your driving record is less than six points, you may apply. However, any new violations that occur before the completion of the probationary process, which put your total score over six points will disqualify you. Annual evaluation of a member's driving record may be made during a member's employment or volunteer service. Any current member found in violation of this evaluation will result in the suspension of driving privileges and/or termination of employment with the Riverside Fire Authority.
